Most wineries offer their own tastings along with various pairings with cheeses or chocolates, for example, some without additional charges.

Most wineries also allow you to share the tastings with your partner. Coppola Winery provided a Cabana and pool for the day at a cost (consider it your own wine pool club for the day),

There was V.Sattui Winery with Italian deli on site and picnic area for you to enjoy your lunch along with some of their wines. Great location easy to get to. A must, do not pass up.

Pedroncelli Winery, in Sonoma, also gave us an education on Zinfadel wine country. Shirley was most gracious and kept telling us this is "Zin country".

We also stopped by Beringer winery the oldest active winery. Our server was Adrian (see photo) who explained how during prohibition the Beringer winery stayed open by offering there wine for medicinal purposes and supplying wine for the clergy, wink wink.

It was also noted that this enabled them to being very active when prohibition was lifted!

One of our favorite stops was Truett-Hurst up in Healdsburg (about 1 hour from our hotel) where we met tasting room and wine club manager Cindi Howley.

The concierge at the Marriott, Lauren, suggested this stop for us and it turned out to be just perfect. Cindi was great and just kept telling us to enjoy the grounds and enjoy the wine.

We definitely took advantage of this local area's very comfortable picnic area which led us

through a wonderful herb/vegetable garden. As we continued through the garden we came upon a creek with nearby tables and Adirondack chairs. Yes we enjoyed the peacefulness of this area very much and wanted to especially thank Cindi for her hospitality.
